Using the Correlation

This correlation is specifically developed as an tool in planning for schools who are using the Reading Mastery (McGraw-Hill Education) Programs. Individualized curriculum plans can be developed for your school or district by the authors of these programs on request.

Wherever possible, a curriculum match has been made to Reading Mastery Classic and Signature Editions and the Series Launcher or Reading for Success novel studies. At the early primary levels Classic I/II and K/I Signature have been correlated to the Series Launchers. At the upper primary and intermediate levels, the novel studies have been matched to Reading Mastery Signature II-V. Once a lesson or story has been completed, teachers can go backwards on the plan, but should not skip ahead. This is more critical at the early primary levels and less at the intermediate and middle school levels. For example, it is best not to skip students ahead to *Genies Don't Ride Bicycles* if they have not completed lesson 126 of RM II Classic or Signature I, L. 126. It is appropriate to have students do the novel study for *Maniac Magee* while they are in RM IV Signature only if they are older students. The recommendation for this title is based on the age appropriateness of the subject matter rather than readability. A teacher with a class of RM Signature V may choose to go back and have their students do the novel study for *Charlotte's Web* if the students have not read this classic previously.
