

Program Goals for Adventures in Language[®] III (2014 Edition)

- To provide students with practice using correct oral language skills. Students will master many different grammar usage skills (e.g., "anyway" rather than "anyways," correct use of "among" and "between");
- To provide students with the skills to determine what makes a complete sentence, using subject and predicate, and to apply this skill to evaluating their own writing;
- To provide students with practice proofreading for punctuation, capitalization, and usage;
- To provide students with written expression lessons that will reinforce the skills taught in formal lessons;
- To provide students with the opportunity to be successful writers through the use of specially designed planning sheets and by participating in the writing process;
- To provide students with the opportunity to become fluent writers within specified time limits.
